We are delighted that you are interested in a quality Catholic education for your child. By making this choice and the sacrifices it brings, you declare your desire for your child to be educated in an environment which proclaims Jesus Christ as our Savior.

It is my pleasure to announce the beginning of registration for the 2019-2020 school year. To register, complete the application in this folder or download from our website at www.ChristChildAcademy.com. This completed application along with your tuition down payment of \$50 is to be turned into the school office. We have included all the necessary instructions in your recruitment packet and outlined this information on the registration form. After processing your registration, a copy will be mailed to you to confirm your spot for the 2019-2020 school year.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program – Beginning in the 2019-2020 school year, Christ Child Academy will be participating in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). Parents who qualify would have 100% of their tuition paid to the school via a voucher from the State. The WPCP application dates run from February 1 through April 20. Please refer to the handout in the recruitment folder for more information.

Grant & Aid Program – All families are encouraged to apply for tuition assistance online through the **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Program** at www.factstuitionaid.com by the **deadline of April 18, 2019**. The Carl and Charlotte Hren Foundation, which sponsors this tuition assistance, requires Christ Child Academy to use **FACTS** and fully accepts their recommendations. All the information submitted to **FACTS** is kept completely confidential. There is a \$30 fee to register. Should you not qualify for assistance, this fee will be returned to your account.

Christ Child Academy also uses **FACTS Management Company** for tuition management. All families must enroll in **FACTS** to pay tuition. Parents may access information about their accounts or pay invoices at any time at online.factsmgt.com.

Extended Day Program – We offer this program for Christ Child Academy students registered in 3K through 5th grade who require before and/or after school care. Registration for the Extended Day Program may be submitted anytime during the year. The director of the program will confirm registration via email. More information and a fee schedule are enclosed in your packet.

Christ Child Academy offers a fully staffed Extended Day Program for children 3 years old through 5th grade.

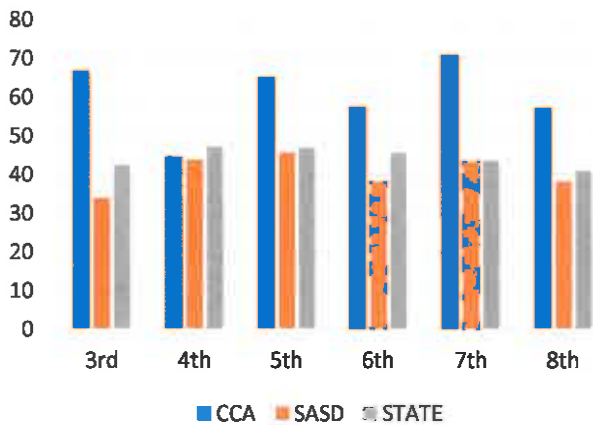
Our Alumni

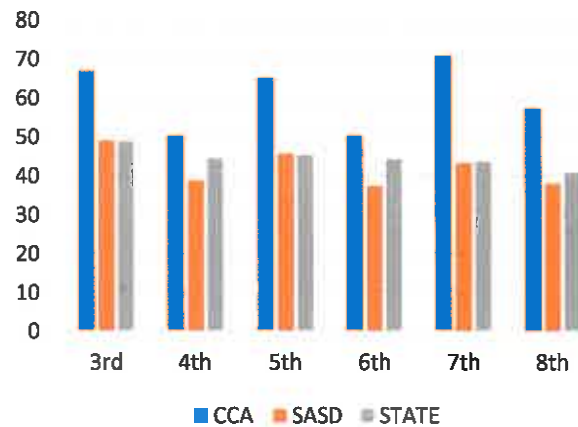
Our Students

The Wisconsin Forward Exam is taken by students in grades 3-8 every spring. The exam assesses English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics in grades 3-8 and adds Science and Social Studies in grades 4 and 8. Based on the results of all CCA students, a “proficiency level” score is determined. CHRIST CHILD ACADEMY PRESCHOOL

Program Summary

Christ Child Academy's pre-kindergarten programs offers a variety of activities in which the children can explore, discover and create according to their own individual abilities in an atmosphere of love and trust which promotes development of self-esteem, accomplishment and a sense of belonging. Teachers plan and take advantage of opportunities for learning that occur as a natural extension of the children's interests and activities.

ART – Many opportunities are available to use different art media in class as well as learning to follow directions to reproduce a project designed by the teacher.

CELEBRATIONS & PROGRAMS – Christmas program, various holiday celebrations, special events, field trip to the farm as well as an "End of the Year" gathering are some of the programs tentatively planned for the year ahead.

DRAMATIC PLAY – Regular opportunities to "make believe" during free time, in specially designated areas are offered. Examples of this would be our dress-up area and role playing in our kitchen space.

FINE MOTOR DEVELOPMENT – Painting, drawing, cutting, gluing and writing activities, as well as opportunities for play with a wide variety of manipulative toys and games.

LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT – Books, poems, songs, nursery rhymes, and an introduction of new vocabulary words and new ways of using and sharing words. Show and Tell is offered which is a good vehicle for language development.

LARGE MOTOR DEVELOPMENT – Activities for exercise and skill-building in the classroom, the school gym, and outdoors as weather permits. Gym time is offered to preschoolers every other week.

MATH - Counting, number recognition, comparison, graphing, categorizing, patterns, calendar, days of the week, sequencing and measuring. A good example of learning math skills is in our cooking unit.

MUSIC – Lots of songs, rhymes and musical activities incorporated throughout the day.

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT – Many opportunities for parental participation in classroom activities is available, including in class helpers with computers and on-hands special projects. Parents are always welcome to visit the Preschool Classroom. Classroom visitors and chaperones need to have completed the "Safeguarding All God's Children" program required by the Milwaukee Archdiocese before joining us in the classroom setting.

READING & WRITING – This consists of name recognition and printing, letter of the week, writing center, alphabet activities, and exposure to a variety of printed materials, including books and stories written by the children.

RELIGION – Stories, songs, visits from pastoral staff, prayers and art activities that help children develop a knowledge and love of God. Christmas and Easter activities focus on the sacred (not secular) tradition of the holidays. Jr. Kindergartners attend Mass on holy days if the holy day falls on a Monday, Wednesday or Friday.

SAFETY – Lessons include safety rules for indoor as well as outdoor activities, a "Meet your School Counselor" for the Jr. Kindergartners in preparation for Kindergarten as well as a program on Protecting All God's Children.

SCIENCE – Learning about nature and the world around us through observation, walks, books and hands on experiences.

SOCIALIZING – This is accomplished through inter-active games, snack time, as well as free time where children have many opportunities to interact with all the other students in the classroom.

Extended Day Program for 2019-2020 School Year

Christ Child Academy Extended Day Program offers Before/After School Programs for *Kindergarten through 5th grade*, as well as 3 and 4-year-old students attending 3K or 4K classes.

Before School Program opens at 6:30 am until 8:00 am. If necessary, children can bring their own breakfast in the morning. The morning consists of activities based on age and interest or completing homework before they are walked to school.

After School Program opens at 3:00 pm (2:15 pm on Wednesday afternoons for early release) and ends until 6:00 pm. The afternoon program consists of outside free time or use of gym, homework, theme/art projects. A snack is also provided.

CCA Extended Day Program welcomes students enrolled in 3K and 4K classes. Children enrolled in 3K and 4K will start at 11:15 am at Extended Day Program. The Program includes lunch, rest time, theme/art, free choice time, and a snack.

- Registration fee (non-refundable): \$30 per child / \$50 per family
- A weekly or monthly schedule needs to be submitted to EDP.
If you have an ongoing schedule that rarely changes, fill out a schedule form once and note the schedule as ongoing throughout the school year or until further notice. However, if your care needs vary, a schedule form will need to be completed weekly, and returned to EDP by the week prior to when the care is needed. Once schedule form is completed, you may add or delete times by emailing Director at ccaedp@gmail.com.
- Fee for Extended Day Program is \$4 per hour for each child.
- Billed in ¼ hour increments. Daily minimum charge is ½ hour.
- A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged per child for pick up any time after 6:00 pm.
- Unscheduled additional day: \$5 fee plus standard hourly charges.
- "No – show" – a child who was scheduled but does not attend will be charge an \$8 fee *per family* to their FACTS account.
- Monthly charges will be added to FACTS account.

It is the belief that these same principles and faith will develop a successful athlete.

Christ Child Academy competes regularly with other schools in the Sheboygan area. The mission of the CCA Athletic Program is to foster a Christian spirit of sportsmanship, fitness, a healthy self-image and the ability to work with others as a team. We accomplish this mission through the collective effort and shared responsibility by all—parents, students, coaches, school staff and parish community.

Christ Child Academy encourages both individual and team excellence and presents students of all skill and experience levels with opportunities to develop a Christian spirit of sportsmanship as well as a lifelong interest in fitness and sport.

The three sports that are offered at Christ Child Academy are girls' volleyball, boys' and girls' cross country which are both held in the fall; and boys' and girls' basketball are offered during the winter. After completing the online application, you will need to upload all required supporting documentation. If you are unable to upload, fax the required documents to 866.315.9264.

The following supporting documents are required to complete the application process:

- **IRS Federal Income Tax Return**, including all supporting schedules (the year of the tax return depends on the tax requirements of your school). If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the same tax year.
- Copies of **all the current year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements** for both the applicant and co-applicant.
NOTE: If you are applying before you have received all the current year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, please submit them as soon as they become available.
- Copies of all supporting tax documents if you have business income/loss from any of the following:
 - Business** - send Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Farm** - send Schedule F and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Rental Property** - send Schedule E (page 1)
 - S-Corporation** - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1120S (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 - Partnership** - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1065 (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 - Estates and Trusts** - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1041 and Schedule K-1

IMPORTANT: If you file a tax return but do not have W-2 wages because you are self-employed, you will be required to submit a copy of your current year **Federal Form 1040 Tax Return**.

- Copies of all supporting documentation for household Non-Taxable Income such as: Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). If you do not file a tax return, you are required to provide documentation of all income received.

All documentation received is imaged upon receipt and then destroyed.

You may log in to your FACTS user account to review the status of your application. Please allow 2 weeks processing time before inquiring further about receipt and/or status of the uploaded or faxed documents. Application deadlines are set by the institution awarding the aid. If you are applying after the deadline, contact your school to ensure that your application will be accepted.

A non-refundable application fee may be required before your application will be submitted.
