This year, the Archdiocese has also designated April 12-18 as Safe Environment Week. In doing so, we can assure that every parish and school, as well as the entire faith community, focuses on the importance of keeping our children and youth safe. This year's theme is "Respect." Respect is a fundamental ethical value, and we are morally obligated to treat everyone we see and meet with respect. St. Vincent de Paul forms are also due April 30, 2015 for families with extenuating circumstances.**

Christ Child Academy offers an Extended Day Program to our students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. The Extended Day Program is open from 6:30 am until 8:00 am and after school from 3:00 pm until 6:00 pm. 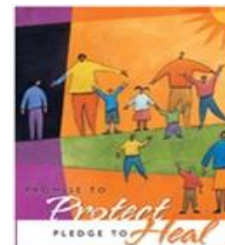
