We are excited to be partnering with Smart Tuition for the processing and collection of tuition and school fees for the 2015-2016 school year. Please go online to enroll by May 1st. This free registration can be accessed at www.enrollwithsmart.com and our school code is **12928**.

Registration for the 2015 - 2016 school year is now underway! Please note: **Open enrollment has begun as of today, April 16th**. Each family who has yet to register will now be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please register as soon as possible.

A reminder to all parents: If you wish to apply for tuition assistance through the Hren Foundation, you must use the **FACTS Grant & Aid Program**. All of the information submitted to FACTS is kept completely confidential. Apply online at www.factstuitionaid.com. Application deadline is April 30, 2015. St. Vincent de Paul forms are also due April 30, 2015 for families with extenuating circumstances.

Christ Child Academy offers an Extended Day Program to our students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. The Extended Day Program is open from 6:30 am until 8:00 am and after school from 3:00 pm until 6:00 pm. During the 2015-16 school year, CCA will also be open for enrolled 3K and 4K preschool students from 11:15 am until 6:00 pm. 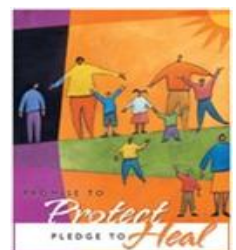
