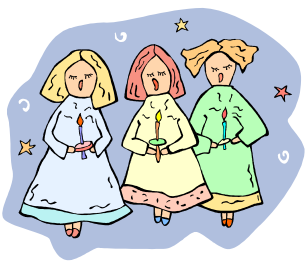

You do **NOT** have to be a "golfer" – this is for fun!! It is a Best Ball Scramble, meaning that everyone will golf but you use the best shot at each hole.

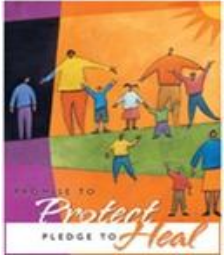
You do **NOT** have to golf – you can come just for dinner, cocktails, raffles & camaraderie.
