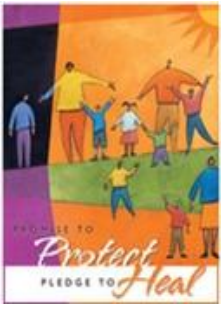
Please Note:
